**Do you need support to get a paid job?
Are you aged 19+ with a self-declared
disability? Our Steps into Work Supported
Internship may be for you.**

What is a supported internship?

- A year-long course based with an employer
- Four days a week
- For people aged 19 and over with a self-declared disability

You will:

- Have the opportunity to work in administration*, catering or facilities
- Be supported by a tutor / job coach and a job buddy
- Be supported to achieve a vocational qualification
- Improve your English and maths skills if you don't already have a Level 2
- Be supported to look for a job, attend interviews and move into work at the end of the course. 75% of interns achieve this

*For administrative roles you will need to have a good level of English (preferably Level 2 or above) and IT skills
